

HOW TO MAKE

A BEE

Glue three pompoms together for the head and body.

Make wings by twisting together the ends of a looped pipe cleaner.

Cut six small lengths of pipe cleaner, bend and fix into shape for the legs.

Add wiggle or paper eyes.



AN ANT

Glue three pompoms together for the head and body.

Cut six small lengths of pipe cleaner, bend and fix into shape for the legs.

Add wiggle or paper eyes and two short lengths of pipe cleaner for antennae.



Glue a lollipop stick to your model to turn it into a BOOK MARK PUPPET or you could now use the model to DECORATE A POTTED PLANT.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- ✱ PVA glue, it works well these materials.
- ✱ Scissors to cut pipe cleaners.
- ✱ Pompoms for bodies and heads.
- ✱ Craft foam shapes or pipe cleaners for wings.
- ✱ Pipe cleaners for legs.
- ✱ Stick on wiggle eyes or paper shapes for eyes.
- ✱ Adhesive tape.

HOW TO MAKE

A SPIDER

Use a pompom for the body.
Cut four lengths of pipe cleaner and bend into shape, fix centrally to the underside of body with tape to make eight legs.
Add wiggle or paper eyes.



A FLY

Make the body by twisting together the ends of looped pipe cleaner. Fix a pompom to the body for the head.
Make wings from craft foam.
Cut six small lengths of pipe cleaner, bend and fix into shape for the legs.
Add wiggle or paper eyes.



A DRAGONFLY

Make body by joining 2 pipe cleaners together (diagram 1), wind this long pipe cleaner round a pencil to make a spiral (diagram 2).
Fix a pompom to the body for the head.
Add wiggle or paper eyes and two short lengths of pipe cleaner for antennae.
