

Friendship Clouds

Each child could show their friendship cloud to the class

Time to make:

30 minutes

Get the children ready for the new school term with these friendship clouds which are fun and easy to make. They're a great way for the class to get to know each other again, expand their vocabulary and practise spelling!

All the friendship clouds could be framed or glued to a big display on the classroom wall!



How to make your friendship cloud:

1. Pick a friend and choose 6 words that best describe them.
2. Draw a cloud on a white card or piece of paper and use the scissors to cut it out.
3. Write the friend's name on the cloud and place it on an A4 piece of coloured paper.
4. Using different coloured paper, cut 6 strips and write the chosen words on each strip.
5. Before gluing the strips arrange them under the cloud, putting the strips in rainbow-colour order.
6. Glue the coloured strips in place.
7. Now for the glitter! Use the glue-stick round the edge of the cloud and dip the cloud in the glitter.
8. Shake off any excess glitter and glue the cloud in place on the coloured card.
