## Time to make:

## 30 minutes

Get the children ready for the new school term with these friendship clouds which are fun and easy to make. They're a great way for the class to get to know each other again, expand their vocabulary and practise spelling!

All the friendship clouds could be framed or glued to a big display on the classroom wall!

## How to make your friendship cloud:

- 1. Pick a friend and choose 6 words that best describe them.
- 2. Draw a cloud on a white card or piece of paper and use the scissors to cut it out.
- 3. Write the friend's name on the cloud and place it on an A4 piece of coloured paper.
- 4. Using different coloured paper, cut 6 strips and write the chosen words on each strip.
- 5. Before gluing the strips arrange them under the cloud, putting the strips in rainbow-colour order.
- 6. Glue the coloured strips in place.
- 7. Now for the glitter! Use the glue-stick round the edge of the cloud and dip the cloud in the glitter.
- 8. Shake off any excess glitter and glue the cloud in place on the coloured card.
